ROLE TITLE: LAB TECHNOLOGIST

LOCATION: A COMMUNITY CENTRE SCHOOL CLINIC – MECHIMERU (Bungoma)

Role Summary: The primary role of the Lab Technologist is to ensure smooth running of laboratory services in the clinic through a sustainable service delivery model in line with the mission, vision and strategic objectives of the organization. He/she will also ensure accurate processing and timely dissemination of results and must demonstrate professionalism, competence and integrity at all times.

Role Details:

- Coordinate day-to-day operations to ensure quality laboratory services are delivered to beneficiaries.
- Provide medical laboratory diagnostic and therapeutic information, products and services by developing and implementing SOPs for all aspects, as well as reporting.
- Maintain medical laboratory equipment performance by establishing quality standards, developing operations, quality and troubleshooting procedures, certifying instrument performance, and arranging for equipment replacement, service, and repair.
- Maintain medical laboratory supplies inventory by checking stock to determine inventory level, anticipating needed supplies, placing and expediting orders for supplies, and verifying receipt of supplies.
- Maintain high standards of hygiene and general cleanliness as well as medical laboratory productivity by monitoring workload of functional areas, identifying peak and slack periods, and making operational adjustments.
- Communicate urgent/critical/abnormal test results within recommended period of time and maintain proper documentation.
- Ensure quality results by participating in quality assurance processes.
- Maintain medical laboratory information system by identifying information needs and problems, recommending improvements to SOPs, establishing priorities, testing etc.
- Implement new programs, tests, methods, instrumentation and procedures
- Maintain regular contact with clients suffering from various diseases to monitor their progress and response to medications by doing baseline investigations.
- Organize and conduct blood drives periodically.
- 4 Participate in continuous medical education for professional development.

Perform other duties as may be assigned by your supervisor from time to time.

Minimum Requirements

- Diploma in Laboratory Technology or equivalent qualification from a recognized institution in Kenya.

- MUST have at least 2 years' practical work experience in a busy laboratory preferably of similar scope of operations.
- Valid and current registration with Kenya Medical Laboratory Technicians and Technologist board (KMLTTB)
- Have good communication skills in English, Swahili as well as interpersonal skills;
- Strong computer proficiency and an appreciation for emerging technology trends.
- Good organizational skills, an enthusiastic approach to work, ability to perform under minimum supervision, pressure and demanding circumstances
- HUST be flexible, self-motivated and a team player.
